▶▶ 2024 NAZARENE FAST FACTS

TOGETHER NAZARENE

The Church of the Nazarene ministers in **165** world areas.

The number of Nazarene churches dropped to **30,747** churches with **2,724,006** members, an increase from last year.

Decadal growth in membership is **20.36%**.

In 2022, there were **468** districts and **33** pioneer areas around the world, with **31,461** credentialed clergy.*

NMI membership for 2022 was **1,042,338** with **19,558** organized local NMIs.

Persons in need were treated at **community-based clinics and health care centers** all over the world with concentrated efforts in India, Papua New Guinea, and Eswatini (formerly known as Swaziland).*

MISSIONS

In 2022, there were **489** missionaries originating from **63** world areas, serving in **91** countries. Of these missionaries, **325** served as global deployed and **164** were sponsored deployed. Last year, there were **60** new missionary deployments. Within these missionary families, there are **306** missionary kids.

Missionary Health Care provided US **\$406,362** in medical assistance for Nazarene missionaries, through offerings, Memorial Roll gifts, and Distinguished Service Award gifts.**

Churches globally gave US **\$36,239,362** for Approved Mission Projects.**

376 retired missionaries received benefits through the Global Missions Pension Plan for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.*

Nazarenes gave US **\$4.2 million** in deputation and missionary support offerings for missionaries.**

NMI assisted Work & Witness in raising approximately US **\$999,576**.

EDUCATION

50 educational institutions, including graduate seminaries/theological colleges, **12** liberal arts colleges/universities, **30** undergraduate seminaries/theological/Bible colleges, **2** nurses training colleges, **1** teacher training college, and **1,032** education centers (extension) had 2022 combined enrollment of **45,124** students globally.*

International Student Scholarship Fund (NMI 80th Anniversary project) provided **88** scholarships for students outside the US/Canada to attend Nazarene theological institutions.

MINISTRIES

ALABASTER

Nazarenes gave US **\$2.9 million** for Alabaster, to fund construction projects in 2022. The Alabaster Offering is used in all 6 global regions.** No Alabaster funds are used for administrative costs.

JESUS FILM HARVEST PARTNERS

JESUS Film Harvest Partners (JFHP), raising **\$4.3 million**, reports that World Evangelism Fund (WEF) helped provide infrastructure for **960** JFHP teams to share God's love. In 2022, teams reported **2 million** evangelistic contacts. Of these contacts, **584,063** indicated decisions for Christ with **366,191** new believers receiving initial discipleship follow-up. Teams started **10,771** Preaching Points in 2022.

WORLD EVANGELISM FUND

NMI and others partnered with local churches to help raise **\$36,942,611** through the World Evangelism Fund during the 2022-2023 fiscal year.**

The total for the World Evangelism Fund and Mission Approved Projects is **\$73,171,973**.

In 2022, **99** districts gave **5.5%** of their income and beyond to the World Evangelism Fund (**54** of which were from regions other than the US/Canada region). WEF giving beyond 5.5% helps open new work, sustains works opened in recent years, and helps send new missionaries that God calls.¹

WORLD MISSION BROADCAST

Nazarenes gave US **\$256,610** to World Mission Broadcast (WMB), providing radio, television, and Internet programs to share the gospel globally.**

COMPASSIONATE MINISTRIES


NMI partnered with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries to give more than US **\$8.4 million**, for disaster response and compassion projects around the world and to support **11,126** children through Child Development Centers and Pastor's Kid programs.**

CARE & CONNECTION

NMI has all 6 regions participating in Care & Connection, creating personalized connections between local church districts, and missionaries around the world. Each connection is vital in continuing to share about the impact of missions.

¹ "New work" refers to new world areas, a geographical area, or new entities such as institutions. Pioneer areas or Phase 1 districts are considered new work. When a district reaches Phase 2, it is no longer a "new work."

ENGAGING CHILDREN & YOUTH

NMI encourages each church on every district to be intentional in providing opportunities of service for children and youth, creating an environment where they can hear and respond to God's call. This can happen through the ministries of Nazarene Youth International and Nazarene Discipleship International together as they engage all ages of the church. We believe nurturing and leadership development are best done in the local church and are individualized to the needs of each and every person.

CARE & CONNECTION

CARE & CONNECTION is provided to every global and sponsored Nazarene missionary who is on contract with Global Missions by their home district.

LINKS is a network of personal connections between missionaries and Nazarene districts around the world. Participating LINKS missionaries are assigned to districts for a year to help foster a personal connection between missionaries and the local church. Both the LINKS and CARE & CONNECTION relationship brings a sense of involvement with Nazarene Missions through regular correspondence, updates from their field of service, and presentations when they are on home assignment.



Gather **NEW** items in quantities listed below. Assemble Crisis Care Kits (CCKs) and seal the Ziploc bags. Include only those items listed below. **DEVIATING FROM THIS LIST CAN CAUSE AN ENTIRE SHIPMENT TO BE REJECTED IN CUSTOMS.** Set the CCKs in groups of six (6) to determine the number of banana boxes needed.

Do not insert money or literature (including anything with the church's name on it, notes, etc.) in the CCKs.

Pack contents below into a clear 2-gallon OR 2.5-gallon plastic Ziploc bag and seal:

- ▶ 1 medium toothpaste (4.0-6.4 oz.)
- ▶ 3 toothbrushes ([in original packaging](#))
- ▶ 1 box of Band-Aids (30 or more)

- ▶ 1 sturdy hair comb

▶▶ SCHOOL PAL-PAKS



Gather **NEW** items in quantities listed below. Assemble School Pal-Paks (SPPs) and seal the Ziploc bags. Include only those items listed below. Deviating from this list can cause an entire shipment to be rejected in customs. Set the SPPs in groups of ten (10) to determine the number of boxes needed.

Do not insert money or literature (including anything with the church's name on it, notes, etc.) in the Pal-Paks or boxes.

These contents will give each student a notebook, 5-6 pencils, 5-6 pens, an eraser, and a ruler. Two students will share the colored pencils, scissors, and sharpener.

Pack contents below in a clear 1-gallon Ziploc bag and seal:

- ▶ 2 composition notebooks (such as Mead brand), no larger than 9³/₄"x -7¹/₂" (No spiral-bound notebooks will be accepted.)
- ▶ package of #2 pencils (quantity: 10-12 pencils)
- ▶ package of black pens (quantity: 10-12 pens)
- ▶ pink erasers, 2-3" long
- ▶ rulers (6" or 12", with metric measurements)
- ▶ package of colored pencils (quantity:12-15)
- ▶ pair of blunt-nosed scissors
- ▶ hand-held pencil sharpener

The presenter (usually a church or district) contributes \$125 to Missionary Health Care.



FAITH PROMISE

Faith Promise is a plan based on missions giving at systematic intervals rather than just twice a year. Through Faith Promise, people pray about the amount they should give for missions (over and above their tithe). The amount is often given weekly, biweekly, or monthly.

HOW TO PREPARE AND PLAN FAITH PROMISE WITH YOUR PASTOR AND COUNCIL:

- ▶ Set the date and plan a Faith Promise emphasis.
- ▶ Discuss your specific responsibilities for the Faith Promise emphasis.
- ▶ Who will be the speaker? Who will book the speaker?
- ▶ Length of Faith Promise emphasis: Saturday? Sunday morning only? Sunday morning & evening? Saturday night and Sunday morning?
- ▶ Plan for special gatherings? Friday evening rally, Saturday men's breakfast, women's lunch, teen pizza party Saturday night?

ASK YOUR PASTOR about a missions bulletin board, the church calendar, and how and when the deadlines are for submitting mission information for the Sunday morning church worship folder, church newsletter, or website.

DISCUSS with your council the amount that needs to be raised for missions for the coming year, starting with the World Evangelism Fund (5.5% of current income), special offerings, local NMI Council expenses, missionary speakers - both care and offerings.

FAITH PROMISE SERVICE: After your speaker gives the presentation, the local president or pastor should instruct the congregation on how to fill out a commitment card or give online.

Nazarene Missions International is the organization responsible for engaging and mobilizing the local church to engage in missions in the Church of the Nazarene and is the denominations' representative for missions on the district and in the local church.

LOCAL NMI PRESIDENT

The role of the local NMI President is to promote NMI in the local church in cooperation with the pastor. You are a voting member of the church board and lead the local NMI council.

- There are five key areas of impact in which every church should participate regardless of their size, location, or language. The local church can have maximum impact on missions in the Church of the Nazarene with your leadership! These are the NMI Top Five Areas of Impact: **PRAYER, WORLD EVANGELISM FUND, ALABASTER, CHILDREN & YOUTH, CARE & CONNECTION.**
- Focusing on these five areas of impact does not diminish other areas of NMI influence. These items are stepping stones to deeper involvement in missions support through the Church of the Nazarene. They are a way to begin to become involved; they are easily understood and we are striving for them to be adaptable in every culture. We aim for each church to participate in these five areas, and then adding additional areas of connection, to match the interests and needs of each local congregation or district.

END OF YEAR REPORTS

The local NMI president is required to complete a Local NMI President's Report at the end of each church year. A majority of the questions are asked from Global NMI and a few are from the District NMI, including a list of recipients of the Memorial Roll and Distinguished Service Award.

Throughout the year, keep a list of outreach participation that your church does as a whole or a few that represented your church during the church year. This will make reporting much easier for you in March. *Example: donated to local food bank, helped with ROC, sponsored a child through NCM, Work & Witness trip to (list country), etc.* Please keep in mind that participation in the Five Areas of Impact is what determines the Mission Priority One Award. These are the baseline for criteria.

NMI DELEGATES FOR OKLAHOMA DISTRICT ASSEMBLY

Delegates shall be church members (15 years of age or older). The number of elected delegates shall be based on the following formula: two delegates (excluding associate members) from each local church of 25 members or fewer, and one additional delegate for each additional 25 members.

AUTOMATIC DELEGATES FOR THE DISTRICT ASSEMBLY:

(The following are considered ex-officio and should not be on your ballot as delegates.)

- ▶ Retired pastors & missionaries
- ▶ Pastors: senior & associates
- ▶ Missionaries on home assignment
- ▶ District superintendent
- ▶ District NMI Council members
- ▶ Lay members of the District advisory board
- ▶ Incoming & outgoing local NMI presidents
